CPO has been experiencing an explosion in growth in the last calendar year! The number that CPO is serving per month has risen over 35% from Jan 2023 (5513 people) compared to October 2023 (8452 people) with our two busiest months of the year still waiting to be counted.

We are up over 40% from Jan 2022 (5030 people) compared to October 2023 (8452 people). We anticipating almost doubling the number of people we have served over that period by year end 2023!





Volunteer Drivers Needed for CPO's Home Delivery Program "CPO Samaritans"

To better serve our neighbors in need, CPO has been piloting a home delivery program for those who are homebound or lack transportation. Due to demand and need, this program is starting to grow, and more drivers are needed. The home deliveries are made on Wednesdays and Thursdays leaving CPO around 10am and it would take about an hour to complete the small route of deliveries. If you, a friend, or family member are interested in becoming a home delivery volunteer please contact Susan Hicks at susan.hicks@ccharitiesdor.org. CPO has purchased an AED and are asking for any active volunteers that are AED/CPR current certified to provide a copy of your current certificate, so that we are aware of those that can help during a medical emergency. The AED is located right outside the food area in the hallway for easy access to either waiting room, the food area or the CPO warehouse in an emergency.
